SPOTLIGHT : THE REAL ESTATE SECTOR IN INDIA

The real estate sector in India is of great importance. According to the report of the Technical Group on Estimation of Housing Shortage, an estimated shortage of 26.53 million houses during the Eleventh Five Year Plan (2007-12) provides a big investment opportunity. According to a report 'Emerging trends in Real Estate in Asia Pacific 2011', released by PricewaterhouseCoopers (PwC) and Urban Land Institute (ULI), India is the most viable investment destination in real estate. The report, which provides an outlook on Asia-Pacific real estate investment and development trends, points out that India, in particular Mumbai and Delhi, are good real estate investment options for 2011. Residential properties maintain their growth momentum and hence are viewed as more promising than other sectors. ULI is a global non-profit education and research institute.

India –Malaysia CECA Signed

India and Malaysia signed a Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement (CECA) on 18 February 2011 aiming in the short term to boost bilateral trade from about \$9 billion in 2010 to \$15 billion by 2015. It was signed in Putrajaya by the visiting Minister of Commerce and Industry of India Mr. Anand Sharma, and Dato' Sri Mustapa Mohamed, Malaysian Minister for International Trade & Industry, in the presence of Malaysian Prime Minister Dato' Sri Mohd Najib Razak. The agreement will come into force from July 1, 2011.



The India-Malaysia CECA is a comprehensive and ambitious agreement that envisages liberal trade in goods and services and a stable and competitive investment regime to promote foreign investment between the two countries. The goods package under the CECA takes the tariff liberalization beyond the India-ASEAN FTA commitments on items of mutual interest for both the countries.

This agreement aims to promote investments and create liberal, facilitative, transparent and competitive investment regime. The CECA purports to protect, promote and remove barriers to foreign investment flows in order to stimulate new investment flows between India and Malaysia.

CEOs from India Visit Malaysia

A high level business delegation led by Mr B Muthuraman of Tata Steel and mounted by Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) accompanied the Minister of Commerce and Industry Mr. Anand Sharma during the visit. The Business Delegation called on the Minister of International Trade and Industry Dato' Sri Mustapa Mohamed and also held discussions with the Federation of Malaysian Manufacturers (FMM) and Malaysian Investment Development Authority (MIDA) for forging partnerships. The Indian business delegation also witnessed the signing of the Comprehensive Economic Cooperation Agreement (CECA).

Main Elements of CECA:

- It contains 16 Chapters and 15 Annexes.
- CECA is ASEAN 'plus' insofar as the Trade in Goods is concerned. The ASEAN 'plus' elements are – (a) advancement of the end-dates for tariff liberalisation under normal track 1, normal track 2 and sensitive track by 3, 6 and 6 months respectively, and (b) additional (ASEAN 'plus') tariff concessions on 76 items by India and on 140 items by Malaysia.
- Both sides have exchanged WTO 'plus' offers under the trade in services. Some of the categories to be covered are Contractual Service Suppliers (CSS) and Independent Professionals (IP) in sectors such as accounting and auditing, architecture, urban planning, engineering services, medical and dental, nursing and pharmacy, Computer and Related Services (CRS), Management Consulting Services, etc.
- The CECA would protect, promote and reduce barriers to foreign investment flows in order to stimulate new investment flows between India and Malaysia.

Bilateral Trade Grows 25% during 2010

India-Malaysia bilateral trade surged during 2010 to US \$8.98 billion marking an increase of 25% compared to the figures of 2009.



Further, real estate companies are coming up with various residential and commercial projects to fulfill the demand for residential and office properties in Tier-II and Tier-III cities. For instance, Ansal Properties has several residential projects in cities such as Jodhpur, Ajmer, Jaipur, Panipat, Kundli and Agra.

Omaxe has also planned around 40 residential and integrated township projects in Tier-II and Tier-III cities, majority of them being in Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Haryana. The growth in real estate in Tier-II and Tier-III cities is mainly due to increase in demand for organized realty and availability of land at affordable prices in these cities.



According to the data released by the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP), housing and real estate sector including cineplex, multiplex, integrated townships and commercial complexes etc, attracted a cumulative foreign direct investment (FDI) worth US\$ 9,072 million from April 2000 to October 2010 wherein the sector witnessed FDI amounting US\$ 716 million during April-October 2010.

Government Initiative

The government has introduced many progressive measures to unlock the potential of the sector and also to meet the increasing demand levels.

- 100 per cent FDI allowed in townships, housing, built-up infrastructure and construction development projects through the automatic route, subject to guidelines as prescribed by DIPP
- 100 per cent FDI is allowed under the automatic route in development of Special Economic Zones (SEZ), subject to the provisions of Special Economic Zones Act 2005 and the SEZ Policy of the Department of Commerce
- FDI is not allowed in Real Estate Business

In the Union Budget 2010-11, the Finance Minister made the following announcements with regard to the real estate sector:

- Allocation for urban development was increased by more than 75 per cent from US\$ 660.3 million to US\$ 1.17 billion in 2010-11.
- Allocation for housing and urban poverty alleviation was raised from US\$ 183.4 million to US\$ 215.8 million in 2010-11
- Scheme of 1 per cent interest subvention on housing loan up to US\$ 21,576 where the cost of the house does not exceed US\$ 43,153 announced in the last budget has been extended up to March 31, 2011 and US\$ 151 million has been earmarked for this scheme for 2010-11
- US\$ 274 million has been allocated for Rajiv Awas Yojna, as compared to US\$ 32.4 million earlier
- Meanwhile, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has revised the norms for urban cooperative banks for giving loans to the housing and real estate (RE) segment. Now, urban banks can use up to 15 per cent of deposits to provide housing, real estate and CRE loans. Earlier, the RBI norm permitted them to use up to 15 per cent of deposits for giving advances to housing loans and other block capital loans.

The relaxed FDI rules implemented by Indian government have attracted more foreign investors and real estate in India. The revised investor friendly policies allowed foreigners to own property, and dropped the minimum size for housing estates built with foreign capital to 25 acres (10 hectares) from 100 acres (40 hectares). The overseas firms welcomed these modifications and they can now put up commercial buildings as long as the projects surpass 50,000 square meters (538,200 square feet) of floor space.



Investment

Total foreign direct investment (FDI) inflows in the real estate sector were recorded at US\$ 27.3 billion in 2008–2009 and US\$ 7 billion in the first three months of FY2009. Approximately US\$ 1.2 billion FDI committed for real estate projects between April and June 2009. Further, FDI in the real estate sector expected to witness a US\$ 21 billion increase in the next 10 years.

New Projects

Private equity fund IL&FS Investment Managers (IIML) is estimated to have invested US\$ 300 million in real estate and urban infrastructure projects in 2010. Godrej Group's real estate company, Godrej Properties and Frontier Home Developers, has launched a residential project in Gurgaon with joint venture partner M/s. Frontier Home Developers Pvt. Ltd. This is a debut residential project in the national capital region (NCR) for Godrej Properties.

Shristi Infrastructure Development Corporation will invest US\$ 444.7 million over the next three years in seven small cities in West Bengal, Tripura and Rajasthan. The money would be used to build integrated townships, healthcare facilities, hospitality and sports facilities, retail malls, logistics hubs and commercial and residential complexes. Realty major Ansal Properties & Infrastructure Ltd plans to invest about US\$ 330.8 million over the next three years on expansion of its existing integrated townships and to develop a group housing project in Haryana.

Tata Housing is planning to launch about 10 new residential projects in both affordable and luxury segments in 2010-11, with an investment of about US\$ 268.9 million along with its partners. Vision India Real Estate, a closely-held business group in the US, is investing US\$ 5 million in Gem Group's upcoming residential project in Chennai. This will be the first joint development project for the US company that is proposing to invest US\$ 100 to US\$ 200 million over the next three years on projects, especially in the logistics arena.

Ramky Estates and Farms Limited, the real estate arm of the Ramky Group, is contemplating to enter Indian market by July 2011. The company is evaluating on land acquisitions in Kolkata and Bhubaneswar. Chennai-based VGN Developers Pvt Ltd has entered into a joint venture with private equity firm Pragnya Fund to initiate a new residential project with an investment of US\$ 20.06 million in the city.

Realty major Embassy Property Developments has entered into a joint venture with MK Land Holding, a Malaysian company that specializes in pre-fabricated affordable housing, to build projects in the affordable housing segment. The proposed project entails an investment of over US\$ 1.2 billion. Thai real estate developer Pruksa Global plans to invest US\$ 218 million in projects in India and launched its first residential project in the country at Bangalore in October 2010.

Housing Project

The International Finance Corporation is in talks with several real estate developers to create large affordable housing projects in India. For FY-09 and FY-10 (fiscal year ending June 30), IFC's highest exposure has been in India. Out of the US\$ 3.5 billion that IFC has committed in India, US\$ 2.5-2.6 billion have been disbursed. IFC will continue to invest roughly US\$ 1 billion in India every year for the next two or



The Road Ahead

According to the Confederation of Real Estate Developers' Associations of India (CREDAI), the affordable housing segment is set to play an important role in India's real estate sector in 2011 on the back of substantial demand ignited by economic recovery.

"Affordable housing will be a key factor in driving the sector and we have already started working on progressive solutions in this area for effective and customised implementation of such projects," Confederation of Real Estate Developers' Associations of India (CREDAI) Chairman Kumar Gera said.

Moreover, 2011 is expected to be a positive year for the real estate sector. The revival is expected to be driven by infrastructure growth, which in turn, can accelerate real estate activities both in the residential [Back to Cover Page](#) as well as commercial spaces.
